WHAT TO DO AT THE SCENE OF AN ACCIDENT



Being involved in a car accident can be scary, knowing what to do can help you stay calm and ensure the safety of everyone involved. Here are some steps on what to do immediately after an accident.

1. STOP YOUR CAR



Bring car to a stop safely, turn engine off and put on your hazard lights.

2. CHECK FOR INJURIES

Check yourself, passengers and others involved are all ok.

3. MOVE TO SAFE PLACE

If your vehicle is drivable, move to the side of the road, or safe location. If your car is not drivable, contact your insurer as they will arrange your recovery.

4. EXCHANGE INFO

Collect the following information from the other drivers involved:

- **CONTACT DETAILS**
- **INSURANCE DETAILS**
- **VEHICLE MAKE, MODEL AND REGISTRATION NUMBERS**



5. SPEAKTO WITNESSES

Ask for the contact details of any witnesses present.

6. TAKE PICTURES



Photograph any damage to both your vehicle and other vehicles involved, as well as the location and scene of the accident.

7. NOTE DOWN DETAILS

Note down the time, date, location, and what you remember about the accident, including weather and road conditions.
